A Tangled Tale



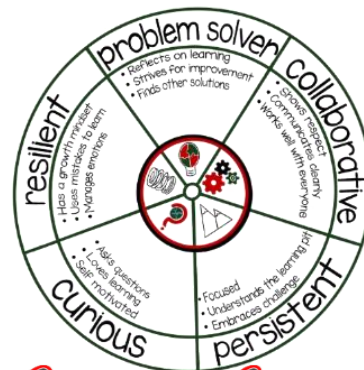

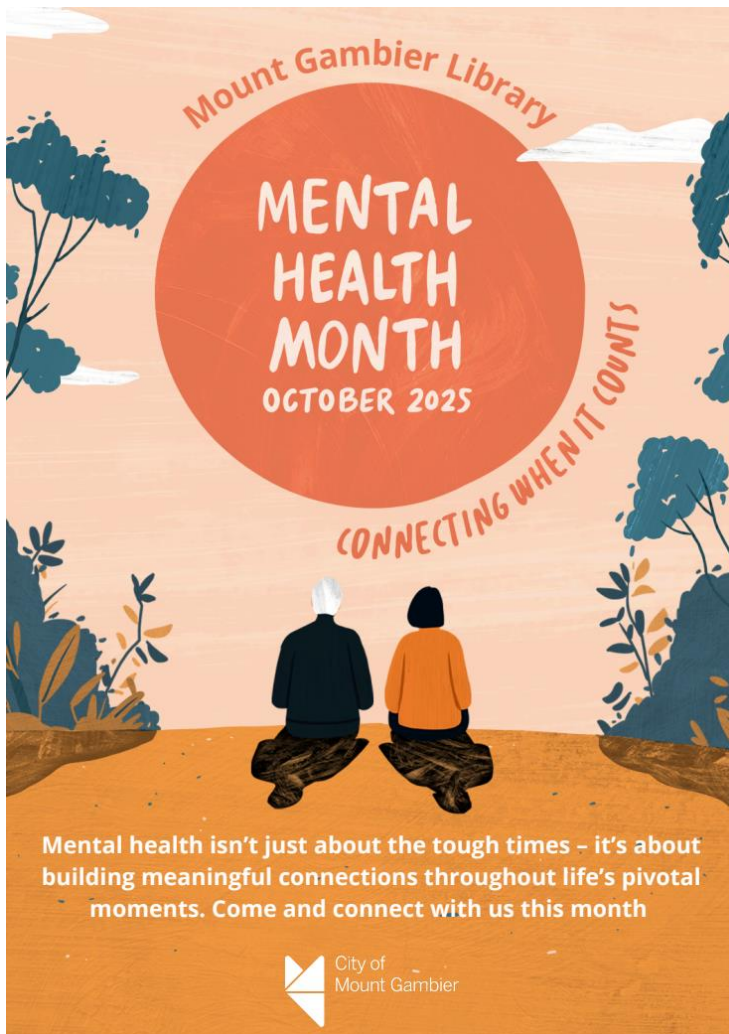
