For parents collecting children early, please park on the road and enter via the pedestrian gate to sign your child out. Families holding a disability pass will be provided with access to the designated disabled parking spaces.

We recognise that these changes may require some adjustment, and we appreciate your support and cooperation. The new fence and gate are being installed as a direct response to parent feedback and are focused on enhancing the safety and protection of all students at Two Wells Primary School.

Room 13 Times Tables Competition



In Week 5 Room 13 competed in the Times Tables RockStars national times tables competition, Oz Rocks. We represented Two Wells Primary School amongst 48 Primary Schools in South Australia and 549 Primary Schools across Australia. Across 3 days, students were able to answer as many questions as they could within a 1-hour time limit each day. In those 3 days, as a whole class, we correctly answered 40,661 questions. Our incredible effort saw us finish 4th in South Australia, and 25th in Australia.

I am incredibly proud of the effort, teamwork and resilience our students showed in this time. Students became noticeably more comfortable and quicker at recalling their times tables over the week.

Every day they were itching to get started!
