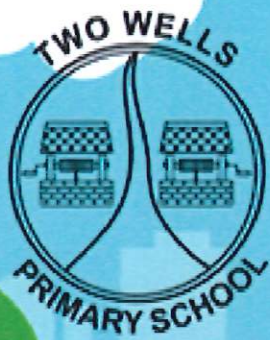
Every Tuesday and Thursday we encourage all students to enter the classroom independently, greet their teacher and friends, unpack their bags, and get started with morning tasks.

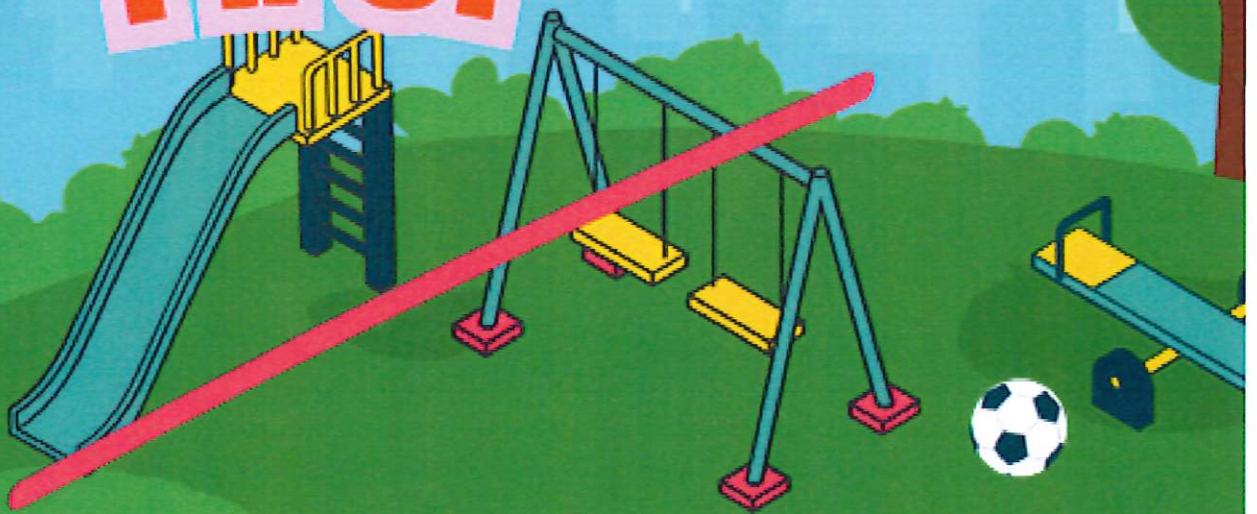

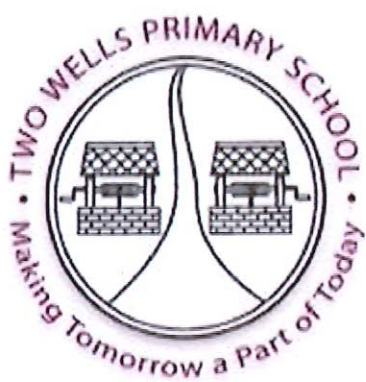

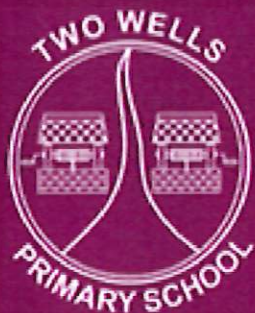
