

DAILY TRANSITION TO SCHOOL

The transition to school each morning can look very different for each and every one of our students, ranging from a sense of excitement to high anxiety. While anxious feelings are common, they usually subside once the situation has passed, or the stressor is removed. All staff at the Hub are committed to supporting our families and students with the transition to school each day, and appreciate this transition can be a stressful time for both parents and the child. To support your child with their transition to school some strategies might include:

- Streamline your morning: make sure your child knows what the routine will be. i.e. they'll be dropped at the gate/the classroom with a big hug and kiss and then they will go inside.
- Talk to your child's teacher/ leadership: staff have a wealth of experience in assisting families with separation difficulties and may have a process to help with morning transitions.
- Be supportive, yet firm: for the majority of children, anxious behaviours end soon after the child leaves you. It is important you remain calm by saying a quick goodbye and offering a final hug and kiss, to demonstrate to your child you are confident they will be safe and supported at school.

The Governing Council invited all Parents/Caregivers to attend the meeting held on 4th November 2024 where any concerns or questions regarding the proposed 2025 Materials & Services charges could be raised.

The fee was ratified at the Governing Council meeting (4th Nov.) at \$355.00.

All Parents/Caregivers of students (Reception – Year 5) will be sent a Polling Letter to approve the full amount of the Materials & Services fees for 2025 to be legally recoverable (where applicable).

The Materials & Services charges are used for items the Government does NOT fund schools for, such as:

- Class Stationery
- Whole School software,
- readers, student library resources,
- games, sports equipment
- photocopying/printing, curriculum resources (Maths/English/Science), technology equipment and programmes.

It does not fund the running costs of the school or staff salaries. We aim to keep the fees as minimal as possible and still be able to provide resources for your child/children.

In 2025 the government rebate towards Materials & Services fees will be \$200 per student which means the cost to parents will be \$155 per child.

- Store chemicals and kitchen utensils safely.
- Reconcile cash sales and take money to the front office.
- Make sure the canteen is a friendly and positive place.
- Attend all Canteen Committee meetings and submit a report in advance.
- Follow the department's work health and safety policy.
- Support any school events as required.
