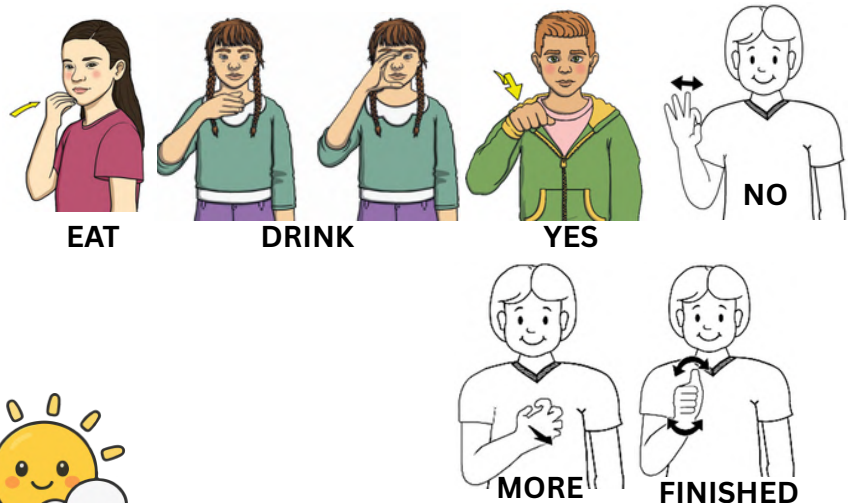

MultiLit (Making Up Lost Time In Literacy)

The Hub are running both MiniLit (Yr 2's) and MacqLit (Yr 3-6's) again this year.

All students are showing progress in these lessons which may be in some or all aspects -

- Words (sightword recognition, reading & spelling)
- Fluency
- Comprehension
- Confidence with reading out loud

Support your child with their learning by -

- listening to and watching them read out loud, correcting as errors occur & encourage tracking with their finger

Please ask for support in choosing appropriate reading level if your child is finding it difficult to read.

Remember books can be borrowed from our well stocked library & public libraries.

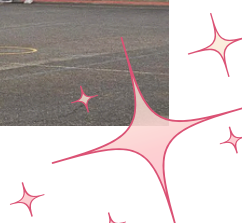

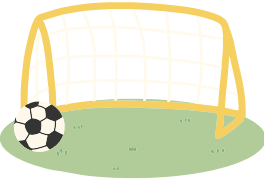


All eyes were glued to the screen last Friday - supporting the **Socceroos** at the World Cup. Will you be up early Saturday morning to support them in the next round?

Pedal Prix



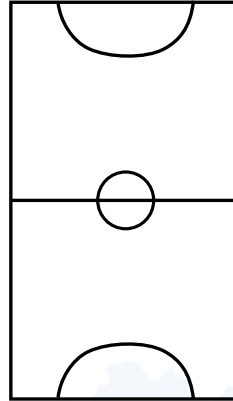

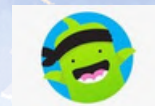
