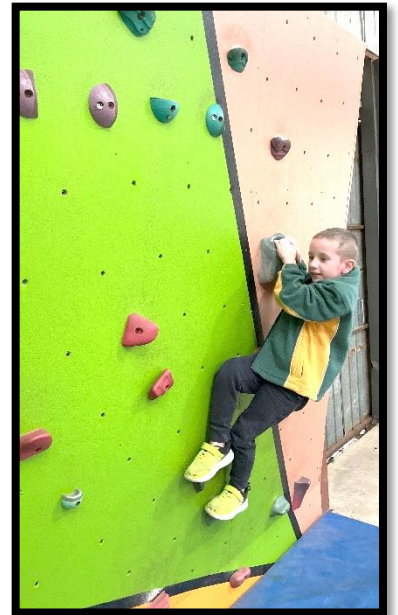
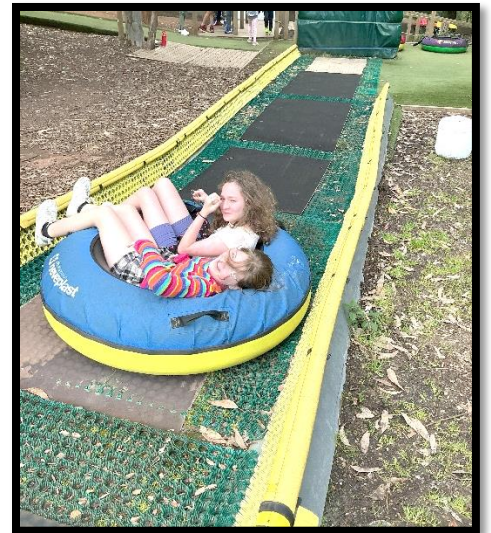

Remembrance Day

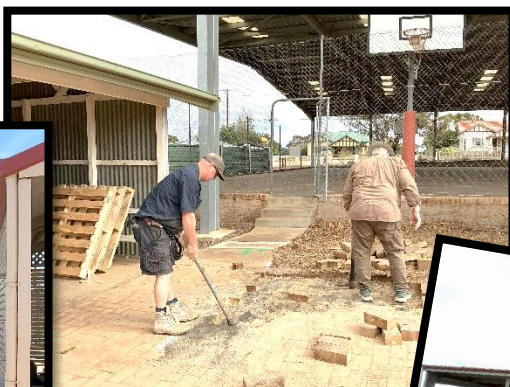
Some of our students and staff attended the community Remembrance Day Service at the local community centre.
