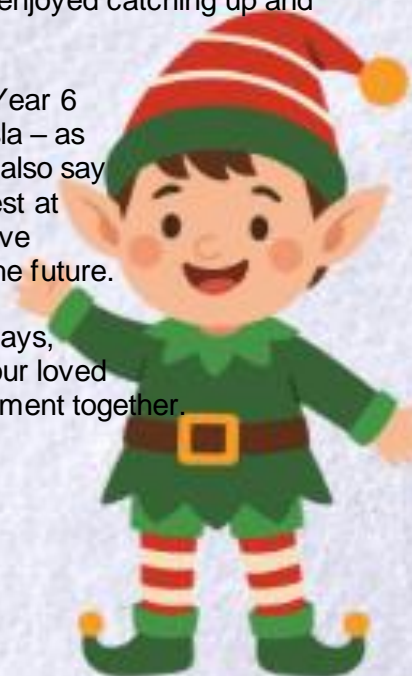
I would also like to thank everyone who came along to the Robertstown Community Lunch last Sunday. I hope you enjoyed catching up and sharing some great food with friends.

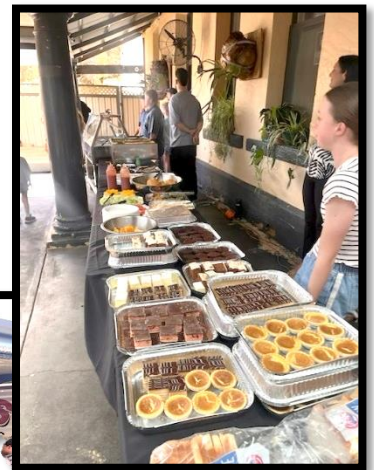
