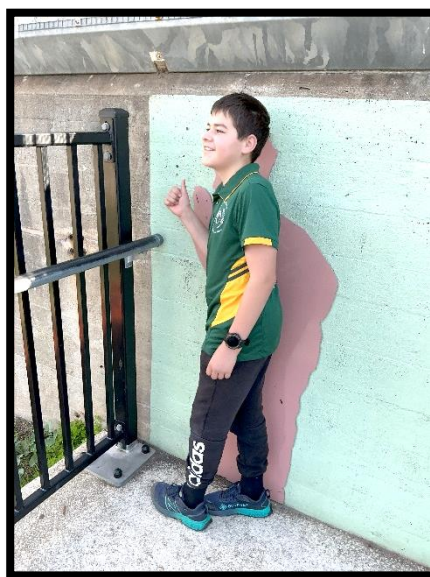
ANZAC Day
