It is a requirement that all members of a household have a Working With Children Check (WWCC) to be able to host an international student and at least one person to undergo the Responding to Risks of Harm, Abuse and Neglect (RRHAN) course and have a certificate to verify that the course has been undertaken. If you do not have any of these certificates, you are able to contact Jo Burgess, the Finance Officer who will be able to organise these for you.

There will be no cost to any family member 18 and over to do the necessary checks. These checks do last for three (3) years.
