School Uniform Dress Policy

Rationale

We believe that wearing a recognised school uniform will:

- Develop a sense of belonging in students.
- Develop public recognition of our students.
- Further develop our image.
- Ensure a good standard of dress and presentation.

Procedures

Dress Code

- Students will be encouraged to wear, and be responsible for, their school uniform.
- Students will keep their appearance neat and tidy at all times.
- Wearing cosmetic make-up and nail polish is unacceptable.
- Excessive or potentially dangerous jewellery is unacceptable.
- School uniform is to be worn during excursions/functions unless the activity makes this inappropriate.
- Suitable footwear must be worn at all times. Backless shoes, thongs and high heels are unacceptable.

School Uniform

Our school uniform consists of bottle green/gold/white/grey/black clothing.

Girls: Bottle green polo shirt or skivvy.
Bottle green broad brimmed hat.
Bottle green jumper/windcheater.
Plain bottle green, grey or black pants, track pants or medium length shorts.
Bottle green or black skirt or skort.
Bottle green/white check dress.

Boys: Bottle green polo shirt or skivvy.
Bottle green broad brimmed hat.
Bottle green jumper/windcheater.
Plain bottle green, grey or black pants, track pants or medium length shorts.

N.B.
- Pants/shorts are not to have stripes, large writing or large logos on them, and must not be leggings or of tight fitting.
- Lock Roos or sporting tops or jumpers are not part of the school uniform.
- SAPSASA merchandise can only be worn in place of school uniform for one week after the carnival/event.

Clothing for Specialised Activities

N.B. In accordance with DfE policy closed in shoes and other PPE (personal protective equipment) will be worn in the following areas:

- Technical Studies Centre

- Home Technology Centre
- Art Centre
- Science Laboratory
- Physical Education

Physical Education (when applicable and for lesson only)

Girls – Sports shorts, skirt, skirt or tracksuit with a T-shirt.

Boys - Sports shorts or tracksuit with a T-shirt.

Tight fitting clothing is allowed in negotiation with the PE teacher.

Sports Day and Swimming Carnival

On Sports Day and Swimming Carnival students are encouraged to wear a T-shirt indicating their team colours (or school uniform) with shorts, skirt or runners and appropriate footwear and clothing.

Optional team attire includes:

- Coloured hairspray for Sports Day, but not for Swimming Carnival.
- Writing on the skin with team coloured zinc cream ONLY if it is a positive, team related message.
- Costumes are not permitted.

Interschool Sports Day - green and gold uniform supplied by the school.

Art/Tech Studies

For Years R-3 a garment will be provided by the school and must be worn. For Years 4-12 an apron is supplied.

Home Economics

An apron to protect school uniform is supplied.

Swimming Activities

Follow swimming pool regulations a t-shirt or rashie must be worn while participating in swimming lessons. When competing in swimming races they can be removed for the duration of the race.

Lost Clothing

Lost student clothing will be available from the front office. Items not claimed at the end of each term will be disposed of in the most appropriate manner.

It is the responsibility of the families to name/rename all pieces of school clothing. This includes underwear during swimming lessons.

Hats

Hats are required during recess, lunch and during outdoor activities (unless directed by teachers) for the entire year. Students are to wear a bottle green broad-brimmed hat.

Hats are not to be worn in class. Appropriate beanies may be worn before school and during lunch and recess time only. Broad-brimmed hats must be worn over top of beanies during recess and lunch.

Purchase of School Uniforms

Uniforms are available for purchase through an online platform. The school has a small selection available for purchase from the Front Office. Second hand uniforms may be available from Lock Stock & Apparel.
