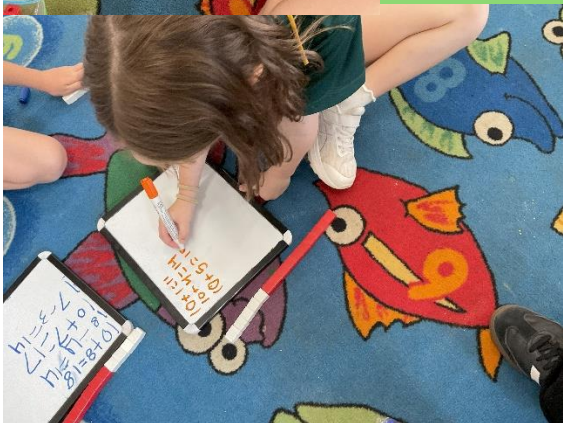
# R/I Crew News

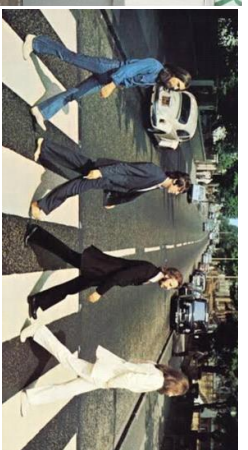
