DREAM AND LEAD CONFERENCE

On Monday 2nd of March, Mr. Beard, Jarra and I attended the Dream and Lead Conference held at the Adelaide Convention Centre. The conference was run by the Youth Leadership Academy Australia and was attended by approximately 500 primary school students and teachers. The aim of the conference was to inspire young school leaders and equip us with the skills and confidence to be change-makers in our school and community and prepare us for leadership in the future. The conference had 3 different guest speakers, all of whom had completely different life stories and inspiration to become leaders in their own right. Dan Aubin, the founder of Daring Humans was the first speaker and our key takeaway from his journey was 'Never Give Up!' The second speaker was Lucy Thomas CEO and co-founder of Prject Rokit. Our key takeaways from Lucy were 'You don't need to be perfect you just need to be brave and to take action' and 'One size does not fit all.' This was in connection to not being a bystander when someone is being bullied. The final speaker was the founder of Youth Leadership Academy Australia, Wil Massara. It was extremely impressive that he began the YLAA at just 15 years old. Our key takeaways from Wil were 'Start messy, just start' and 'Being a young person has never been easy.' Both Jarra and I would highly recommend Mr. Beard taking future school leaders to this conference as it was an opportunity for us to make connections with other students and to listen to their leadership journeys.
