Bushfire Safety Update

Bushfire safety remains a key priority at Kangaroo Inn Area School. This term, we will be conducting fire drills with staff and students to ensure everyone knows what to do in the event of a bushfire.

We remind all visitors and families that signing in and out is essential. This helps us keep an accurate record of who is on site should an emergency occur. Please sign in at the front office if you are visiting and let us know if your child needs to leave during the school day.

To further enhance our fire safety, the Department for Education and Telstra are piloting an initiative at our school to boost mobile phone coverage in the hall, our designated fire refuge area. The school is also funding an antenna for the satellite phone to ensure it works from the hall and a diesel generator to maintain power to communication devices and water pumps during outages.
