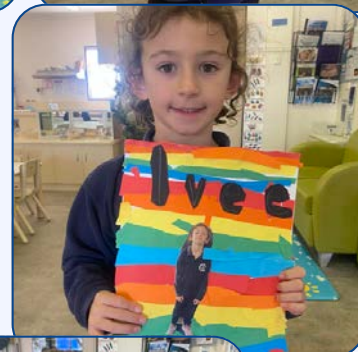

Parent Welcome Afternoon

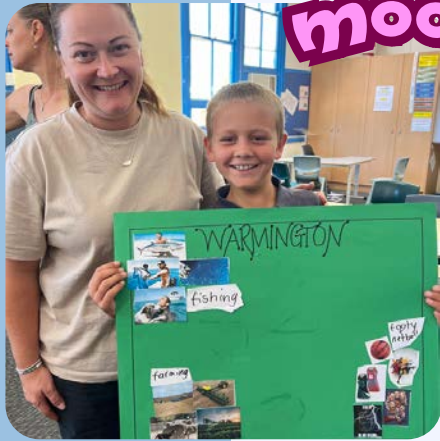

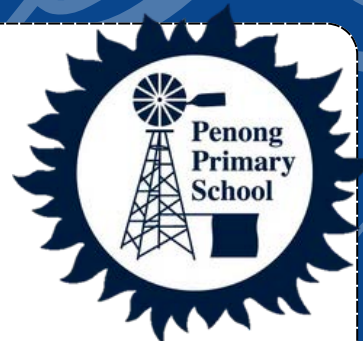
