This term in Room 6 we have been busy exploring the world of **measurement** through lots of hands-on activities We have loved getting involved in practical tasks that make our learning meaningful and fun! We started by looking at **length**, where we have used counters and blocks to compare and measure different objects. We enjoyed seeing how things in our classroom could be longer, shorter, taller, or smaller. We have also explored **mass**, using a range of scales to weigh objects both in the classroom and outdoors. We were so excited to predict which items would be heavier or lighter and then checked our answers. We have also been learning about **capacity**, and measured using teaspoons, tablespoons and cups, working together to see how many small units it takes to fill a larger container. We cannot wait to transform into a class of wizards and scientists as we create our very own potions, mixing different amounts of colourful liquids next week!


- Enrolment forms: due ASAP

- 8. Pay via card




