Why Talking With Babies Is Super Important (and Super Fun!)

Did you know your voice helps your baby's brain grow?

Talking with babies and young children helps them learn new words, how to talk to others, and get ready for reading and learning later on.

Even if your baby can't talk yet, they are listening. They watch your face, hear your voice, and learn from every word and sound.

Here are some fun ways to add talking into your day—no fancy stuff needed!

Talk While You Tidy

Turn cleaning into talking time! When folding laundry, hold up a sock and say, "This sock is red! Can we find the other one?"

Your child learns about colours, matching, and everyday things—while you get things done!

Sing Conversations

Try using a sing-song voice or make up a little tune about what you're doing:

"I'm changing your nappy, snappy-snappy-nappy!"

This makes words fun and helps babies listen to sounds and rhythm.

Wonder Out Loud

Ask little questions, even if your baby can't answer yet:

"I wonder where that butterfly is going..." or "What's that sound?"

It helps your child learn how to be curious and how conversations work.

Make Talking Silly

Use different voices for different toys!

Maybe the lion says, "Roar! Hello!" and the bunny whispers, "Let's hop!" Babies love funny voices, and it helps them learn how to make sounds too.

Box Talk

Give your child a cardboard box and talk about it:

"This is a big box! Let's climb inside. Uh-oh—where did you go?"

Even simple games help your baby learn new words and ideas.

Everyday Words Make a Big Difference

You don't need apps or flashcards. Your voice, your time, and your love are enough.

The Power of Your Voice: Why Talking to Babies Matters (and Can Be Lots of Fun!)

Your voice is one of the most important things in your baby's world. When you talk, your baby is learning. They hear words, feel your emotions, and begin to understand how to connect with people.

Even if your baby can't talk yet, they are listening closely. Every word, sound, and smile helps their brain grow.

Want to make talking part of your day? It's easy—and you don't need any special toys or apps!

Name the Face in the Mirror

Look into a mirror with your baby. Point and talk:

"There's your nose—boop! And here's my big smile!"

This helps your baby learn about body parts and get to know themselves.

Snack Talk

Mealtimes are great for chatting!

"This apple is crunchy! Can you hear it? Crunch, crunch!"

Talk about how food tastes, feels, and looks. Say words like "chewy," "cold," or "yummy."

Describe the Action

When your child plays or draws, say what they are doing:

"You're drawing circles—round and round!"

This helps your baby learn action words and understand what things mean.

Stuffed Animal Chats

Use a soft toy to talk to your child:

"Hi! I'm Bear. What are you doing today?"

Then show how to answer: "Oh! You're playing with blocks? That sounds fun!"

This shows your baby how talking works between two people.

Say Goodnight to Everything

At bedtime, say goodnight to things in the room:

"Goodnight bear. Goodnight lamp. Goodnight noisy truck."

Hearing the same words each night helps your baby feel safe—and remember new words.

Let Them Lead

When your baby looks at something or points, talk about it:

"You see the bird! It's flying fast!"

This makes words match what they are thinking about—and that's how learning sticks.

Every Word Counts

You don't need anything fancy. Just your voice, your time, and your love.

Whether you're driving, giving a bath, or cuddling before bed, talking helps your baby feel close to you—and grow smarter every day.

So go ahead—chat, sing, ask questions, and play with words.

You're giving your child a great start, one word at a time.
