You may use this area for drop off and pick up only, for a maximum of 2 minutes. You must not queue or wait here. The driver must remain with the vehicle.

No Stopping Signs/ Yellow Lines



Both No Stopping Signs and Yellow Lines mean the same thing. There might be one or the other or both. Drivers must not stop or park to which this restriction applies, even if you are stopping for a short period to pick up a child. You cannot stop near a school crossing, always follow the signs and yellow lines.



Bus Zone Signs

You must not stop within a bus zone at any time.
