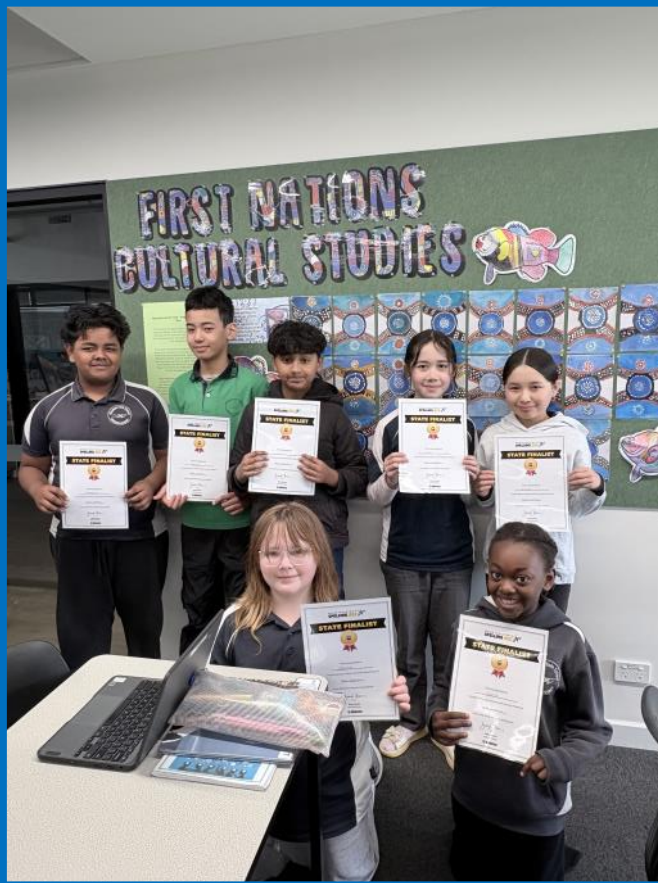

This means they were in the top 200 spellers in South Australia — what an incredible achievement!

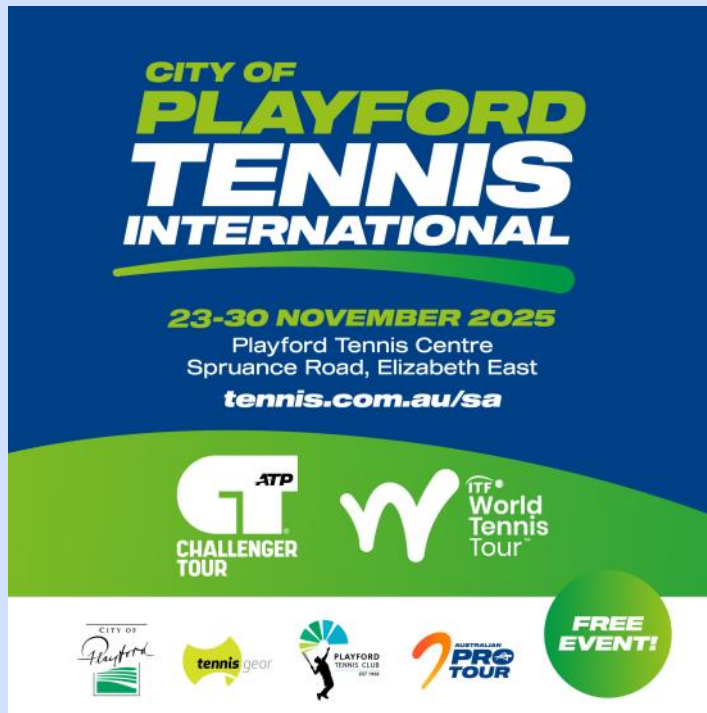
