

MIL LEL PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Reviewed October 2024

Students are expected to wear the school uniform at all times, including on special occasions such as excursions, visits and sports events.

The uniform has been deliberately designed to give a number of options so that families can choose the combination which best suits their needs.

The main identifying components are:

- a green monogrammed windcheater or green woollen jumper
- the colour combination of green/gold/white/black

The following is the description of our school uniform:

Summer Uniform Options

Green and white check dress

Gold or white polo-shirt or Mil Lel sports uniform polo-shirt

Bottle green or black trackpants, shorts, skort or leggings *(see note below)

Grey trackpants or shorts are suitable as a back-up.

Bottle green windcheater or green jumper (school logo can be applied).

Winter Uniform Options

Bottle green or black trackpants, shorts, skort or leggings *(see note below)

Grey trackpants or shorts are suitable as a back-up.

Bottle green windcheater or green jumper (school logo can be applied).

A long-sleeved T-shirt in uniform colour may be worn under polo-shirt for warmth.

Green or gold skivvy or polo-shirt or Mil Lel sports uniform polo-shirt

Socks or tights should be in uniform colours where possible.

Additional notes

Leggings must be thick sport style (not transparent or opaque tights) and suitable for school activities, with no large logos.

Appropriate footwear must be worn.

No denim to be worn (shorts and jeans).

Shorts/skirts to be an appropriate length for school activities.

Jewellery to be kept to a minimum.

No make-up.

Hats

All students are expected to wear a bottle green broad-brimmed or bucket hat (no caps) in Terms 1, 3 and 4. Students are also expected to wear hats when the UV levels reach 3 or above. Hats may be purchased from the Front Office.

Beanies

Students may wear a green beanie (optional school logo- Hip pocket) in Terms 2 and 3. Beanies do not take the place of hats in terms 1, 3 and 4 (See Sun safe policy)

Uniforms may be ordered through Parent Club once per term.
