Elizabeth Grove Primary School supports staff by making their work environment positive and manageable. We have a clear 5-year plan, use consistent practices across the school, and manage workloads well. This helps reduce unnecessary stress and allows staff to focus on teaching and supporting families.

At Elizabeth Grove Primary School, leaders, peers, and coaches work together to help staff build their skills. Staff support each other when helping families with complex needs, so it's not the responsibility of just one teacher. Everyone is encouraged to speak up and ask for help early. This supportive environment helps staff handle challenges, develop their skills, and provide safe and consistent learning for students.
