Dear Parents/Caregivers

This year we are transitioning to **Daymap**, an online learner management system that incorporates parent/teacher interviews, and can be accessed via computer or device by downloading the free App.

Daymap will not be that dissimilar to the previous P/T Interview platform, being quite efficient and user friendly.

In order to book your interviews, you will need to access Streaky Bay Area School's Parent Portal.

Parents will have received emails from the school regarding Parent Teacher Interviews. Please take the time to read these as they outline how to log into & access the new Daymap Parent Portal.

Yesterday, links to access the portal & guides on how to use & book Parent -Teacher Interviews were sent by email. A hard copy will be sent home with the youngest child today including an information sheet & map of teacher locations.

At the moment we are only using Daymap for Student Attendance & Parent Teacher Interviews. We have
