- Click on Communication Tab at the bottom of screen
- Click new message
- Select Absence Notification
- Choose the correct date
- Select the Absence Reason
- Select the child you are reporting the absence for
- Type a brief message, this can include the expected return date or more information relating to the reason

It is an Education Department requirement to have parent/guardians provide the school with a reason unless a student exemption form has been granted prior to the absence.
