In order to book your interviews, you will need to access Streaky Bay Area School's Parent Portal.

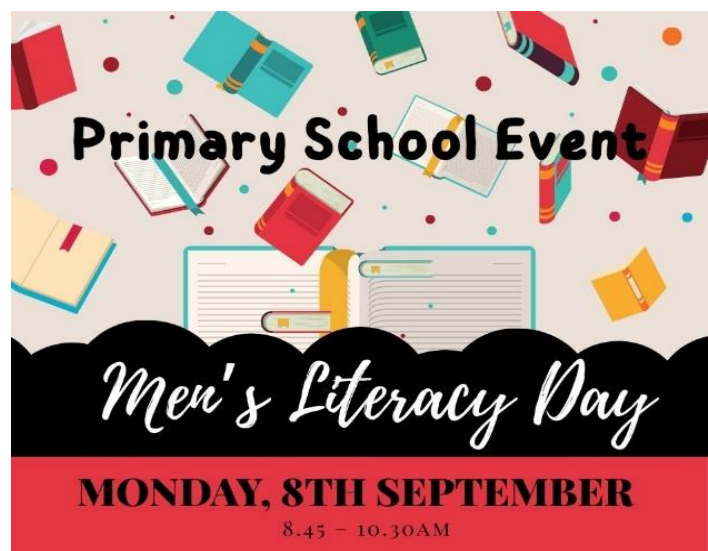
On Monday you will receive a notification in the *Daymap* App that you can click on and book your interviews.

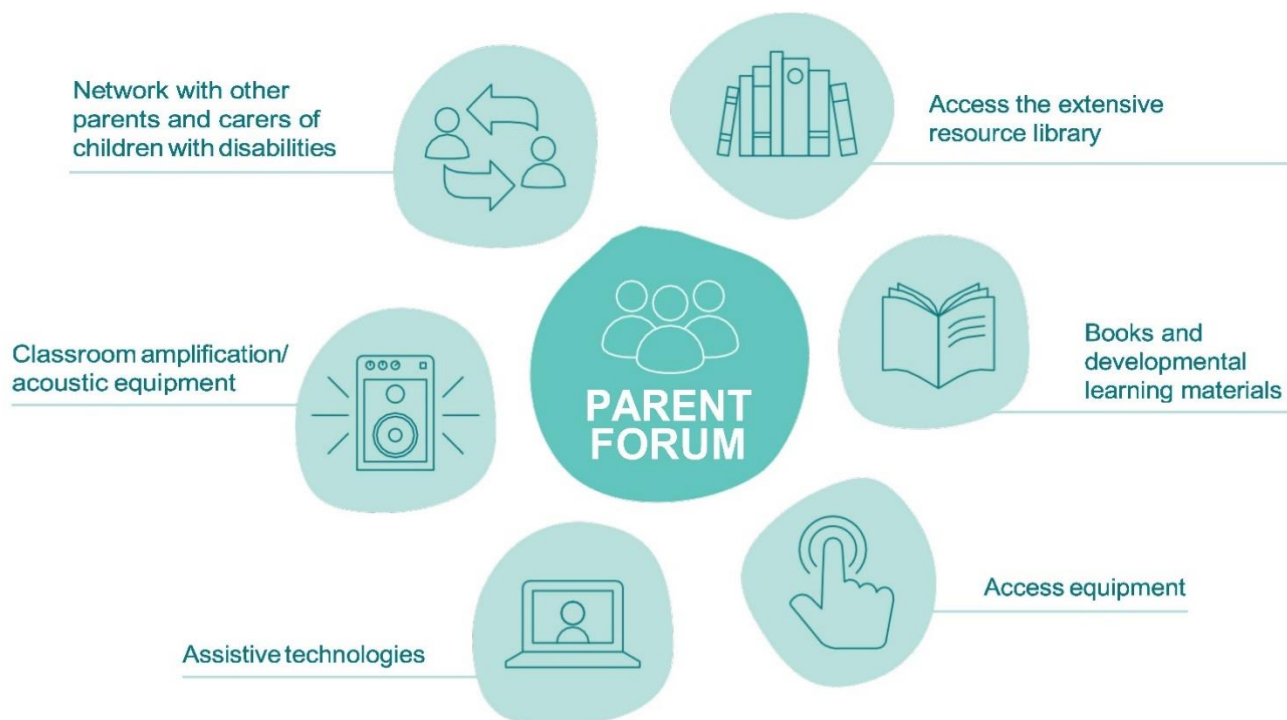

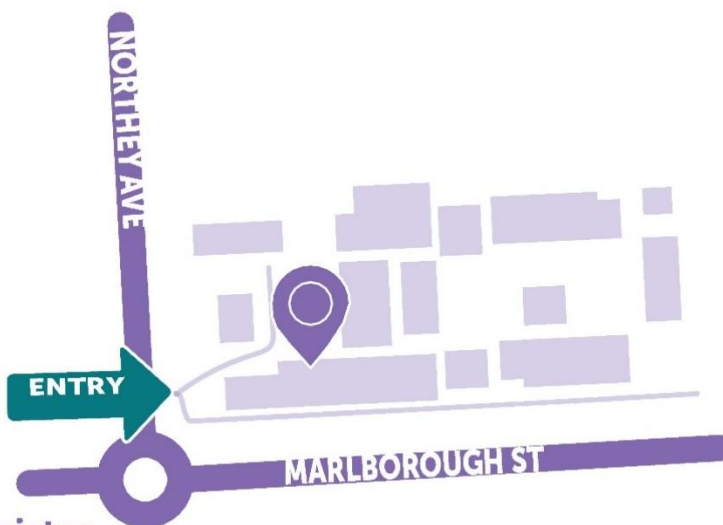
LOCATION AND ACCESS
