EARLY DISMISSALS

EARLIER BUS DROP OFF DUE TO EARLY DISMISSAL

ATTENTION BUS FAMILIES: Please note that buses will be approximately one hour earlier for the afternoon drop off on Thursday 2 April as school will finish at 2pm.

DAYMAP ABSENCES

Families may see that your child is still marked as unexplained when looking at absences on the Daymap Companion App even though it has been changed by admin on the timetable. This is because you are seeing the timeline, the school sees the timetable. The timeline was designed to be a timeline of events, they don't change, because that was the event at the time. Once you have replied or read the absence, it still stays in the timeline of notifications.

If you want to check to see if absences have been updated, click on the photo of your child, this will bring up the timeline, click the hamburger (3 lines) on the left then go to Attendance. Updated absences will show in brown all other unexplained absences will stay red if no message has been received and updated by the school.
