Support for children 5 – 8 years

The [National Thriving Kids](#) model helps to give children the best start in life by identifying those with additional developmental needs earlier and connecting them to support .

Through this model , families and carers can connect with services to increase awareness of developmental delays and to build their skills.










Every child grows and learns in their own unique way. For some, extra support can help them build skills and confidence.

Access to Thriving Kids is not based on diagnosis but on the developmental support needs of a child.

For children with neurodevelopmental differences such as Autism, early assistance can make a big difference in helping them thrive, including by supporting those in their life better understand their individual communication styles, skills and needs and to support them as they grow and learn.
