We are proud to continue offering these opportunities and thank our families for supporting their children to embrace the challenge. Together, we're helping to shape confident, capable and connected young people.

#### **Student Free Day Recap**

On our recent Student Free Day last Thursday, we had the privilege of hosting over 160 educators from across our Murraylands Partnership primary schools. The focus of the day was the South Australian Curriculum (Mathematics), with a particular spotlight on the learning dispositions that are woven through the curriculum.

These dispositions—such as being resilient, resourceful, and reflective —play an important role in shaping how children approach their learning. They help students develop the confidence to persevere when things are challenging, think creatively when solving problems, and reflect on their strategies and progress.

It was a fantastic day of collaboration and professional growth, and we are proud to have welcomed so many colleagues from neighbouring schools into our community. By building strong professional networks and continuing to strengthen our own knowledge, we ensure that students at Tailem Bend Primary School-and across the region-are supported to thrive in all aspects of the curriculum.

The SRC chose to support this service because it is a service which helps sick children living in rural and remote areas of SA and NT.

## Year 1 / 2 Class


### Term 3 has been BUSY!

We welcomed Mrs. Bruce back from her holiday and made her an amazing "Welcome Home!" banner






