EP Field Days Excursion

In week 4, our Year 9/10 Agriculture Management class went on an excursion to the EP Field Days at Cleve. We had the task of gathering information about our passion projects that we are undertaking this term. We had to ask experts questions about how to improve our projects and any relevant information related to the agriculture industry our project relates to. A few of the places we visited were Nutrien, Vitera, Lienert Engineering, Allflex, Cooper's Animal Health, X AG, Crop Smart and PIRSA. We learnt how to treat sheep for lice and what product to use, how malt barley is made, general sheep advice, sheep diseases, how to keep soil healthy, how to turn produce into products, and how to conduct trials. We had a great day exploring the EP Field Days event and adding to our agricultural knowledge.








