Excursions	All students attending excursions are required to wear school uniform unless otherwise stated in communications sent home.	

 If students cannot wear school uniform on a particular day, then they are required to have a written explanation (note from home or email from parent - please do not use ClassDojo messaging as we do not check this and respond to messages sent as per our Communication Policy).

 Students not in school uniform will be unable to access the oval at recess and lunch times. This is for the safety of your child. The wearing of school colours allows staff to quickly identify potential intruders and promote safety within school grounds

A standard note/sms will be sent to families when their child is not in compliance with the dress code.

Prior to the sending of home communication the student will be reminded and provided with the opportunity to wear correct uniform.
