Operating Hours

OSHC operates between the hours of 6.50am and 6.00pm.

Children who are not picked up by 6.00pm will incur late fees of \$1.00 per minute for the first 15 minutes and \$5.00 per minute thereafter. Please ensure to call the service if you are running late.

Fees

\$75.00 per day, per child. This is our full fee without Government Assistance

Bookings

Bookings must be made via the Hubiello App or via text message to 0488 200 207. Some days are capped due to venue requirements and once we are full a waiting list will be in place.

Any outstanding fees are to be paid in full before booking

New families must complete an online enrolment.

Please ensure you have sign your child/ren's permissions slips for excursion days - if these are not received, your bookings will be cancelled

We will provide you with as much notice as possible if an excursion is to change.
